

New Public Water System
Notice of Elevated Water Pressure – August 2026

Residents within the Town of Verona Water District Extension #3 southern alignment (shown below - Foster Street, Foster Corners Road, Sandhill Road and NYS Rte 31) are herein notified that water pressure in the newly installed water main may be greater than your current water pressure generated by your well supply and pressure tank. Public water system pressure will generally range from approximately 70 to 90 psi at your service connection to the main.

A pressure reducing valve (PRV) is planned to be installed on the new NY Route 31 water transmission main within the next few months near Station Street. Once installed, the PRV will help regulate and reduce water pressure within your area to approximately 60 psi.

The higher public water pressure conditions could result in damage to your interior plumbing system if not rated for these higher pressures. If you believe your plumbing may not be suitable, we would suggest consulting with a licensed plumber regarding your interior plumbing system. Residents who have concerns may delay their public water service connection by the Town's Contractor until after the new PRV is installed and placed in service near Station Street, currently scheduled for November 2026.
